***“Borders” or “Setting Triangles”** – since this quilt is on point, you will need triangles around the edge in order to make your quilt square. These “setting triangles” are different sizes; the 4 corner triangles are smaller than the side triangles.

For the **corner triangles**, you will need to cut **2 squares (4 1/4")** each on the diagonal to get 4 triangles (2 from each).

For the **side triangles**, you will need to cut **6 squares (7 5/8")** on BOTH diagonals. You will get 4 triangles from each square.....**figure out how many squares you need to cut by counting the side triangles and dividing by 4.**

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
