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ELEMENTARY (Quilt-As-You-Go) QUILT

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I am going to pin and then I like to pin this other seam that I pushed down. I like to pin that in place. Now earlier, I probably showed you a bad habit to get into not using very many pins. If you are having problems with this fabric bunching up when you sew it, then you are going to need to use more pins. So I would put a pin here. I might put a pin in the center if I am having problems, and I also might put two pins there. I am going to take another pin over. And last but not least, I like to pin the edges here just to make sure that I finish up. I want to make sure that this is lined up.

Another reminder that when you are sewing regular patch work, you want everything to be nice and neat in a row. When you are sewing these Quilt As You Go squares, sometimes all of this won't be nice and even. If you have something that is a little bit larger, a little bit smaller, just try to take the average of the two and sew there. Once again, this quilt is very forgiving. So I have got this pinned, take it over to the machine. I am going to sew $\frac{1}{2}$ (half) of an inch down, just like I did before. After I get finish sewing that, I'll come back and pin this last section on.
