## ELEMENTARY QUILT Supply List

### Fabric:

Fabric squares (100% cotton; 7" by 7")

- to make a quilt 18" by 18" you will need 18 squares;
- if you use 2 different fabrics you will need about 1/2 yard

Batting squares (6" by 6")

- for the 18" by 18" quilt you will need a piece of batting this size to cut out 9 squares
- (about 1/3 yard of 44"/45" batting)

Binding

- 1/8 yard of fabric

### Cutting:

Rotary cutter, ruler and mat **OR** scissors (paper and fabric), ruler, graph paper/template material, glue, marking pen/pencil

### Marking:

Ruler, marking pens/pencils **OR** tape

### Sewing:

By Machine:

- sewing machine in working order with all-purpose needle
- thread/bobbin to match/contrast with fabric
- leader/follower for chain piecing
- pins
- walking foot (not necessary but helpful!)

By Hand:

- needle
- thread
- scissors
- pins
